Master Session	In Galician language
Laboratory practises	The student will gain ability to access statistic and bibliographicla sources, organize and combine concepts and indicators (GDP, population, GDP per capita, openness index, participation rate, unemployment rate, productivity). Additionally, the student will calculate growth rates, indicators in nominal and real terms, index numbers etc. In each lab session the student will write an essay type questions on selected topics . The students will start writing a report in the lab session and will complete/improve it outside the lab-session.
Autonomous troubleshooting and / or exercises	Complementary activities of personal work (outside the lab-sessions and lectures). The students develop the capacity for autonomous learning.

Laboratory practises	In each lab session the student will write differentiated essay type question on selected topics based on information and the analysis of the results using economic analysis .
Tests	Description
Short answer tests	Multiple choice questions in order to check basic knowledge in each chapter.

Long answer tests and development	In order to explain the major economic issues arising within each topic area of spanish enconomy and world economy each student will answer to specific questions. Each student will start writing a report in the lab session and will complete/improve it outside the lab-session following a list of steps.
