On the one hand, the final examination that will cost until 60% of the note (6 points) and, on the other hand, the continuous evaluation that will weigh until 40% in the final note (4 points).1.-Final examination (on 6 points):&*nbsp; it will realise in the official date established in the calendar of examinations.2.-Continuous evaluation (until 4 points): the continuous evaluation will realise by means of the delivery of a report of the analysis of data *macroeconómicos Europeans realised in the computer classroom (will cost 15% of the final note), and execution along the *cuatrimestre of a work/project of individual form on a subject related with the contents of the matter, and that previously will have chosen the student of between a series of proposals (will cost 25% of the final note)TO BE ABLE TO APPROVE THE MATTER IS NECESSARY NOT OBTAINING A NOTE OF 0 IN ANY OF THE ELEMENTS OF EVALUATION And REACH A MINIMUM OF 3 POINTS ON SIX IN THE FINAL EXAMINATION&*nbsp;In the announcement of July keeps the note of the continuous evaluation. Therefore, the examination will cost a maximum of 6points.IMPORTANT NOTEThe students that by notable reasons and properly justified can not receive to the face-to-face modality and, byso much, can not realise the continuous evaluation, will have to realise equally an individual work by 25% of the note, and will be able to realise in the official date established in the calendar&*nbsp;an examination by 75% of the note. In said examination will evaluate the global competitions of the matter.
